SHROVE TUESDAY PANCAKE SUPPER

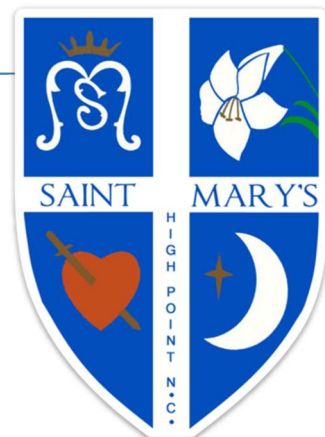
